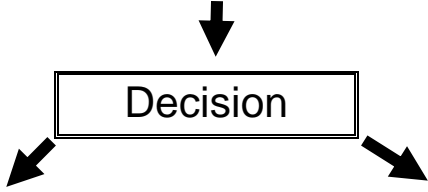


Which is the best electricity tariff for me?

Tariffs as at 1 January 2017



Flat Rate Scale should be more economical for me:

1. I live in Alderney for less than 6 months of the year.
- or
2. For my garage, workshop or other area which has its own separate electricity supply.

Domestic Two Part Tariff should be better for me because:
I live in Alderney for most of the year.

Recommended:

Flat Rate Scale at 30.38 pence per unit + Fuel Cost Component.

Note: there is a minimum quarterly charge of 25 units in addition to meter rental.

Recommended:

Domestic Two Part Tariff at 17.81 pence per unit + Fuel Cost Component.

A fixed Quarterly Standing Charge is applied:
for up to 6 rooms @ £6.97 per room
further rooms @ £5.25 per room
(Rooms 250 sq. ft. or more count as 2 rooms)

Separate tariffs apply to:

- Water heating**** - 10.00 pence per unit + meter rent for a designated permanently wired supply to a water heater only, for example an immersion heater or similar. A minimum quarterly charge of 25 units is charged plus meter rental.
- Storage heaters**** - 10.00pence per unit, (off peak) 11pm to 7am, with midday boost 12.30 to 3.30pm (one hour later during British Summer Time) on a designated supply. Minimum quarterly charge of 25 units is charged plus meter rental.
(** Fuel Cost Component applies to these tariffs too.)
- Pay as you go meters** - 38.00 pence per unit Flat Rate, or 28.00 pence per unit when used for a water heater.
- Meter rental** - Single phase £1.45 per meter per quarter. Three phase £4.35 per meter per quarter.
