



Which is the best electricity tariff for me?



**Decision**



**Flat Rate Scale should be more economical for me:**

**I live in Alderney for less than 6 months of the year**

**Or it's for my Garage, workshop or other area which  
Has its own separate electricity supply**



**Recommended**

**Flat Rate Scale at 34.50pence per unit + Fuel Cost Component**  
**Note: There is a minimum quarterly charge of 25 units in  
addition to the meter rental.**



**Domestic Two Part Tariff should be better for me because**

**I live in Alderney for most of the year.**



**Recommended:**

**Domestic Two Part Tariff at 21.40pence per unit + Fuel cost component**  
**A fixed Quarterly Standing Charge is applied: for up to 6 rooms @ £8.37 per  
Room, further rooms @ £6.30 per room.**  
**(Rooms 250sq.ft. or more count as 2 rooms)**

**Separate tariffs apply to:**

**Water Heating \*\* 12.01pence per unit+meter rent for a designated permanently wired supply to a water heater only, for example an immersion heater or similar.**

**Storage Heaters \*\* 12.01pence per unit (off peak) 11pm to 7am, with midday boost 12.30 to 3.30pm (one hour later during British Summer Time) on a designated supply. (\*\*Fuel Cost Component applies to these tariffs too.)**

**Pay as you go meters \*\* 38.00pence per unit Flat Rate, or 28.00pence per unit when used for a water heater.**

**Meter Rental \*\* Single phase £1.74 per meter per quarter. Three phase £5.22 per meter per quarter.**
